

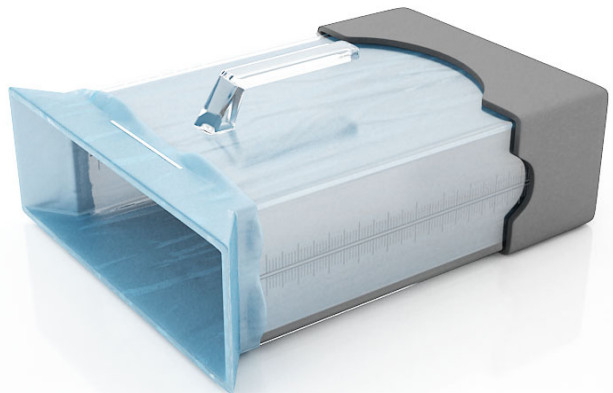
Improved Bowel Cup and Liner Help Medical Professionals Better Assist Bedridden Patients with Bowel Movements

Measurement markings are present on the side of the cup to accommodate bowel samples for the patient, if necessary. Overall, the tool offers a much safer, cleaner, and more secure method of containing bowel movements for bedridden patients.
