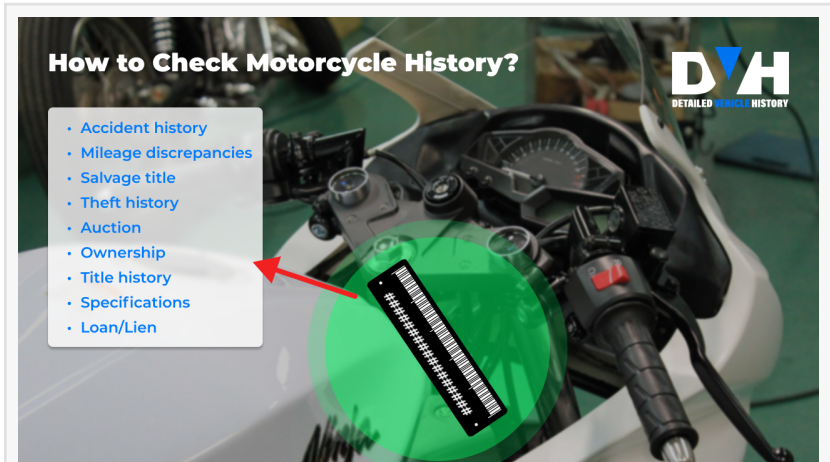
It is now possible to conduct a [Yamaha VIN check](#) or to run checks on all other motorcycle makes.

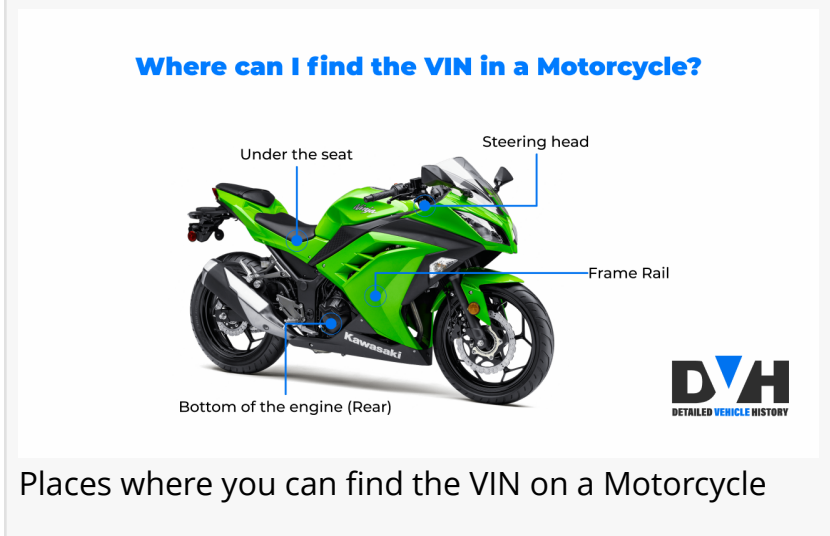

A VIN check uses this code to access various databases, revealing information such as:

Accident history: Were there any previous accidents reported?

Places where you can find the VIN on a Motorcycle

Mileage discrepancies: Is the odometer reading accurate?

Salvage title: Has the bike been declared a total loss?

Theft history: Was the motorcycle ever reported stolen?

Auction: Has the bike been to an auction before?

Ownership: How many people have used the motorbike before now, where, and for how long?

Title history: What is the current title, has the title ever changed before now?

Specifications: This check also provides specification information

Loan/Lien: Are there any outstanding debts?

To run a VIN check simply find the vehicle identification number of the motorcycle in question, which is usually on the right side of the frame near the steering head, front downtube, headstock, engine block, title or registration paper, etc.

Take note that the position of the VIN may vary according to the manufacturer. Then complete the following steps:

Navigate to the form on the ["motorcycle VIN check"](#) page

Enter the VIN and fill out the form

Select "Check VIN."

Receive and review the comprehensive motorcycle history report after checkout.
