The Temporary Restraining Order was granted based on the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (CFAA)

EL PASO, TX, UNITED STATES, July 5, 2024 /EINPresswire.com/ -- On July 2, 2024, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Luciano Aguayo and Armando Gonzalez, the former owners of RedGear, LLC, in the case of ReachOut Technology Corp. v. Luciano Aguayo & Armando Gonzalez, Case No. 24 CV 3408, based on the federal Computer Fraud and Abuse Act, a statute designed to protect against computer hacking.
