- 2. Panama leads in internet speed and stability, crucial for remote work.
- 3. Nicaragua offers the most affordable cost of living, ideal for budget-conscious nomads.
- 4. El Salvador ranks highest in safety, addressing a common concern for travelers in the region.
- 5. Costa Rica and Panama are currently the only countries in the region offering specific digital nomad visas.
