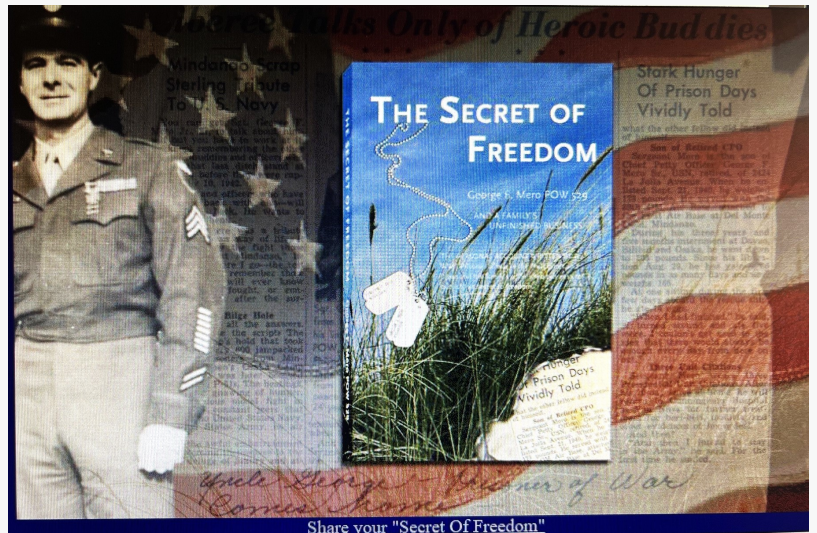


WWII POW's Inspiring Story of Survival and Family's Mission to Publish Manuscript, POW 529

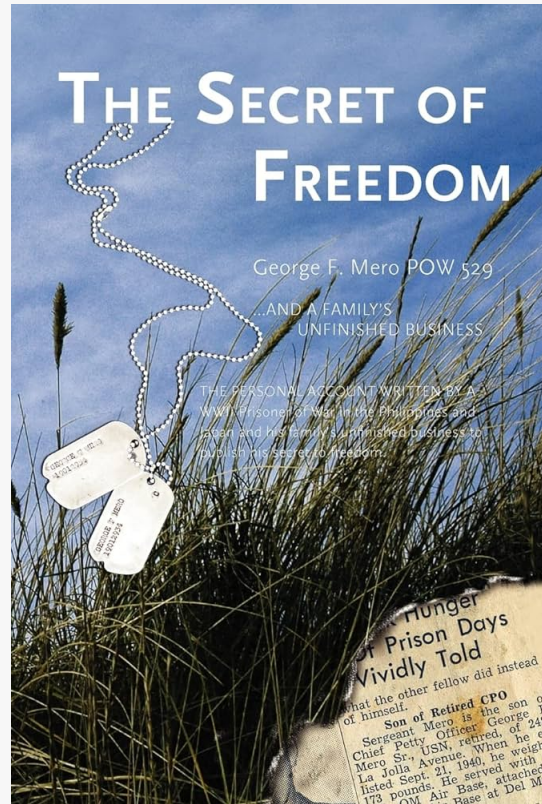
