organizations move beyond proof of concept (POC) projects to achieve production-level deployments with confidence and reliability.


The platform is the first of its kind to embed SafeAI and <u>Responsible AI</u> capabilities at the agent level.

The platform's Responsible AI modules include capabilities such as reflection for instruction




adherence, groundedness to ensure fact-based outputs, and context relevance to maintain retrieval accuracy.

Complementing this, the SafeAI modules include tools for toxicity control, PII redaction, prompt injection handling, and bias detection, along with human-in-the-loop processes to ensure oversight.

Together, these modules provide robust safeguards that maintain trust and compliance in AI deployments.

In addition to improving safety and reliability, Lyzr Agent Studio introduces a hybrid workflow orchestration model, combining large language models (LLMs) with machine learning (ML) agents to create more deterministic workflows.

In a recent deployment, a Fortune 500 company using this model for change request risk analysis reported an improvement in agent accuracy from 59% to 87%, demonstrating the tangible impact of this approach.



The platform is accessible to both technical and non-technical users, making it a versatile tool for organizations. Developers can use APIs to build agents that integrate LLMs and ML models, while business users can create AI-powered tools independently through a no-code wizard.

These options democratize the development of AI agents, enabling teams across functions like HR and marketing to adopt AI solutions without reliance on engineering support.
