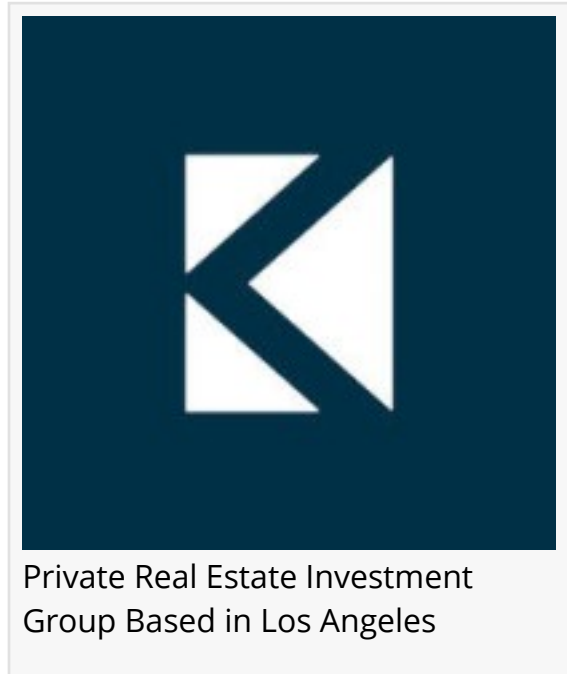


# K3 Holdings and Alpine LA Properties Commemorate National Homeless Persons' Remembrance Day
