*This collaborative visit aimed to identify opportunities for future partnerships and foster systemic change.*

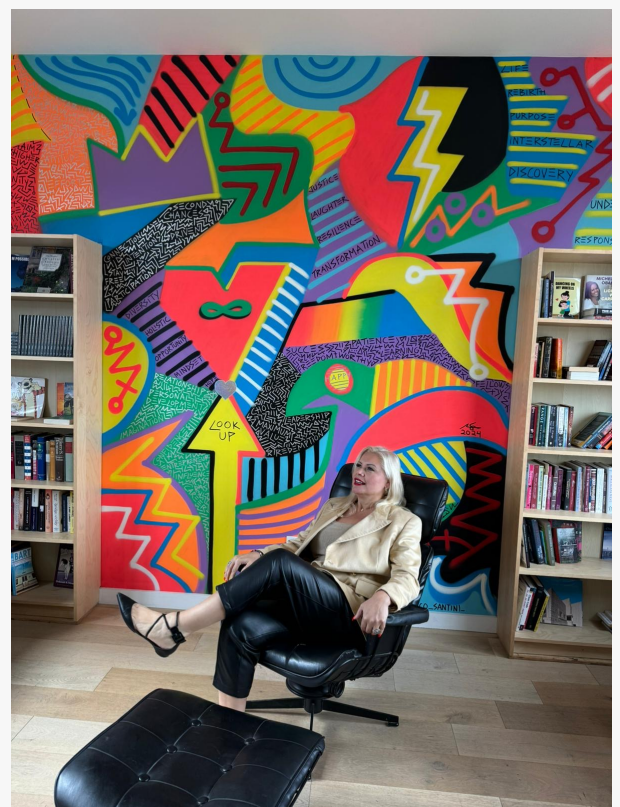
