Based on type, the training gloves segment was the largest in 2021, capturing more than half of the global boxing gloves market, and would lead the trail through 2031. However, the others

segment is estimated to witness the fastest CAGR of 5.8% during the forecast period.

Based on buyer, the institutionalsegment captured the largest market share of more than three-fifths of the global boxing gloves market in 2021, and is expected to lead the trail during the forecast period. The individual segment, however, is likely to achieve the fastest CAGR of 4.9% through 2031.

In terms of material, the PU leather segment captured the largest market share of more than three-fifths of the global boxing gloves market in 2021 and is likely to maintain a noteworthy growth during the forecast period. However, the others segment is likely to achieve the fastest CAGR of 7.4% through 2031.

Based on region, the market in North America was the largest in 2021, accounting for nearly twofifths of the global boxing gloves market share, and is likely to maintain its leadership status during the forecast period. Moreover, the market in the Asia-Pacific region is expected to manifest the highest CAGR of 5.7% from 2022 to 2031. The other regions analyzed in the study include Europe and LAMEA.
