

Understanding the H-1B Visa and Its Annual Cap  
The H-1B visa is specifically designed for foreign professionals seeking employment in specialty occupations that typically require a bachelor's degree or higher in a related field. Each year, there is a cap of 65,000 new H-1B visas, with an additional 20,000 visas reserved for individuals holding advanced degrees from U.S. universities. Because of these numeric limits, competition for H-1B visas can be intense and leaves many qualified candidates without sponsorship opportunities after the annual quota is reached.

Recognizing the need for alternative pathways, MyVisaJobs developed the Cap-Exempt Employer Search Tool to empower users by connecting them with organizations not subject to the standard H-1B cap restrictions. These cap-exempt employers can hire eligible foreign workers at any time of the year, greatly expanding opportunities for individuals who may have missed the
