Source food locally to cut down on carbon footprint. Plant-based options are a great option since they are lighter on the environment and provide a selection of organic or biodynamic wines. Consider serving drinks in bulk to avoid cans and bottles that can accidentally make their way overboard. Use natural elements for decorations including seashells, driftwood, and flowers. Solar or LED string lights are great for ambiance when entertaining at twilight or evening. Also, skip balloons or streamers if the occasion is a celebration — they're awful for marine life.

Offer Music...And Possibly "Live" Entertainment

Consider a Bluetooth speaker with rechargeable batteries. There are a lot of excellent waterproof choices available that will allow anyone with a smartphone to play deejay. The ultimate, however, is if one of the guests can provide live acoustic music.

Ensure the outing is "green" by

bringing recycling and compost bins onboard. Consider a couple of tasteful signs that educate your guests on the importance of not littering in the lake and ocean. Even consider including a QR Code on the signage where guests can donate to an organization such as <u>The Ocean</u> <u>Cleanup</u>, which is committed to cleaning up 90% of floating ocean plastic by 2040.
