



THE AMERICAN HINDU JEWISH CONGRESS JOINS IN SUPPORT OF THE ABRAHAM ACCORDS AND ITS PROMISE OF RELIGIOUS TOLERANCE

WASHINGTON, DC, UNITED STATES, May 22, 2025 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Arthur Kapoor, Chairman, American Hindu Jewish Congress (AHJC), joined with the Abraham Accords Prosperity Group to discuss the next steps following President Donald J. Trump's successful trip to the Middle East last week.

The Abraham Accords, officiated by President Trump, on September 15, 2020, was a commitment by three Arab nations – Morocco, United Arab Emirates, Bahrain – to normalize relations with Israel. Sudan, Oman, and Kosovo later joined the Abraham Accords during President Trump's first term in office.
