

Ellaidhoo Maldives by Cinnamon premieres Tripod's animated tale and invites guests into a living conservation story

MALDIVES, June 18, 2025 /EINPresswire.com/ -- <u>Ellaidhoo</u> <u>Maldives by Cinnamon</u> marked World Sea Turtle Day with the official launch of an animated short film centred around "Tripod," a resident Hawksbill sea turtle born with three flippers who has become a symbol of resilience at the resort's house reef.

The event, held on the island, welcomed guests to the first public screening of the video, which tells Tripod's story and underscores the importance of marine conservation. The film was also released online across the resort's digital platforms to increase awareness of ocean protection among a wider audience.

In addition to the video launch, guests

attended an educational presentation by Ellaidhoo Maldives by Cinnamon's in-house marine biologist. The session provided insight into the threats faced by sea turtles in the region, the ecological role of reef systems, and the resort's broader sustainability initiatives. These include coral propagation, species monitoring, and research-based practices aimed at protecting the surrounding marine environment.

As part of the initiative, a new collection of Tripod-themed T-shirts was introduced at the resort's boutique. Proceeds from each purchase will go directly toward funding Ellaidhoo's conservation programmes, allowing guests to support marine life protection efforts during their stay.

To further engage visitors, the resort installed an interactive display board near its Marine Biology Unit. The board shares details of Tripod's journey and encourages guests to record their own sightings of the sea turtle, who is frequently observed in the surrounding reef. This feature supports the resort's goal of increasing awareness and guest involvement in ongoing environmental initiatives.

Ellaidhoo Maldives by Cinnamon continues to implement sustainabilityfocused programmes that contribute to biodiversity protection and marine education in the Maldives.
