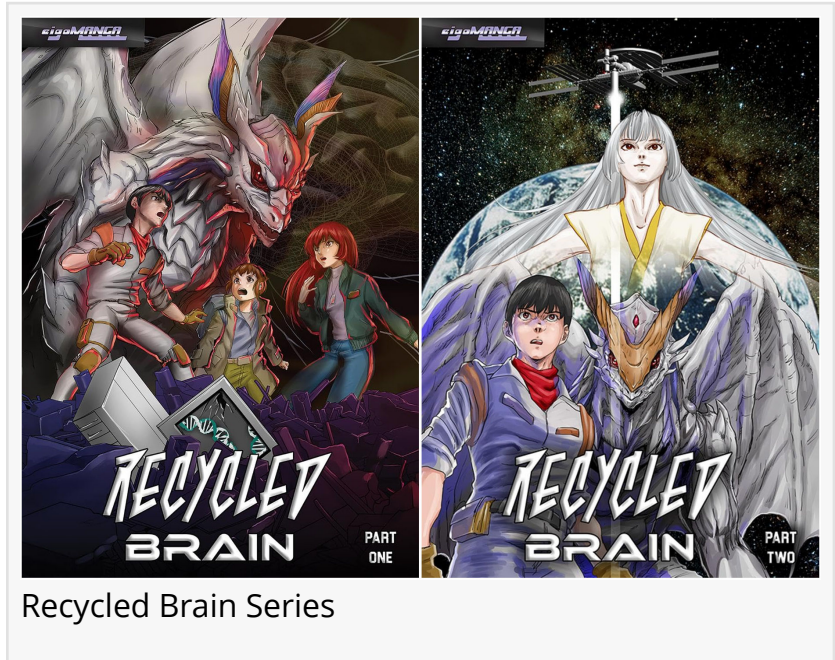

Creator's Engagement with Science and Art

Takahiro Yonemura is actively collaborating with the technology driving the future rather than only writing about it. His scholarly work, including a highly lauded thesis published in The Society of Art and Science's DIVA (Journal of Arts), exhibits emotional behavior, but does it really possess emotional? directly influences "Recycled Brain".

Yonemura exhibits a sophisticated attitude to AI and creativity. He is open to the newest AI technology, or innovative uses, such as personally directing his controversial marketing books for "Recycled Brain", writing, and making experimental artists, such as a featuring video on YouTube of his favorite pet dog singing and dancing with a human voice using AI.

Yonemura, though, underlines a key difference: No generative AI is active in the creation of the manga's illustrations themselves. This balances a clever balance: employing AI as promotional and preparatory gear while ensuring the human aspect in the very artistic output of the manga.

A Multifaceted Talent

Yonemura's talents extend beyond AI research and manga writing. He is a published writer with multiple works, teaches via school lectures and online through platforms such as Udemy, and a composer as well. Under the name "A-Burnery", he has published a commercial music CD by the same title as the manga, to further interest people in his work. The album may be obtained on major music distribution outlets.
