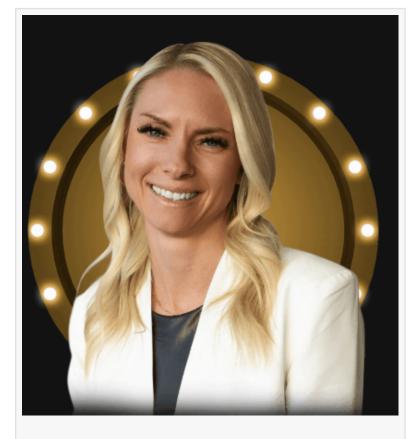


Lindsay Taylor Joins Legacy Makers TV to Share Insights on Healing, Hope, and the Power of Human Connection
