Jacob Way emphasized the event's focus on healing: "In these turbulent times, Charlie's example teaches us that true strength comes from faith, not division. Let's gather to honor him by choosing peace over violence. This isn't just a farewell—it's a battle cry for all of us to step up, just as Charlie did, and make America a place of grace and resolve."
