NEW ORLEANS, LA, UNITED STATES, October 2, 2025 /EINPresswire.com/ -- New Orleans <u>Jazz</u> Orchestra (NOJO) announced today that following an emergency meeting of its Board of Directors held Saturday September 27, 2025, it has parted ways with Artistic Director Adonis Rose effective immediately. NOJO is currently identifying Interim Artistic Director prospects after which a nationwide search will be conducted for a permanent appointment.
