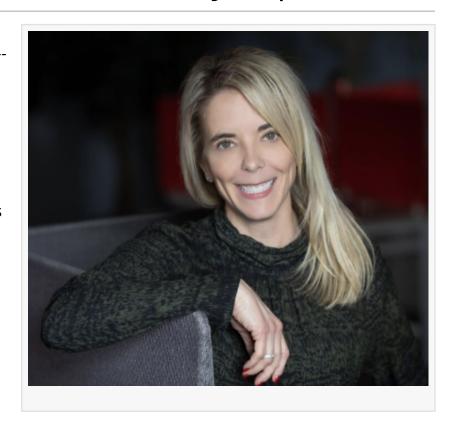


Shannon Van Buskirk Featured in Influential Women as a Leader in Philanthropy, Communication, and Community Impact
