This groundbreaking annual event will mark the first nationwide celebration dedicated to the professionals preventing animal suffering before it begins.

Peer-nominated awards will also recognize veterinary technicians, surgeons, and staff who have gone above and beyond in their service. Together, these honors represent a nationwide movement of prevention in action and acknowledge those who form the foundation of humane animal welfare.
