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By Material Type

In 2021, the plastics segment contributed to nearly three-fifths of the global market share and is anticipated to maintain its dominance by 2031. The Asia-Pacific region dominated the market in 2021, holding nearly half of the global hazmat packaging revenue. The region is also forecasted to exhibit the highest CAGR of 5.7% from 2022 to 2031, primarily due to rapid industrialization, expanding manufacturing capacity, and

stringent safety regulations across countries like China, India, and Japan. Other regions analyzed in the report include North America, Europe, and LAMEA.
