10,000 Volunteers and Counting — A Grassroots Army with a Purpose

Since the soft launch of the Colorado First campaign earlier this month, the response has been electric. Over 10,000 volunteers — from ranchers in the San Luis Valley to single mothers in Colorado Springs — have signed up to support what they see as a once-in-a-lifetime movement.

Campaign offices are being set up not as command centers, but as community empowerment hubs, where Coloradans can access resources, share ideas, and take part in shaping their state's future.

Carlos Ramirez, the campaign's Director of Community Relations, said, "This isn't politics as usual. These are people who've had enough — enough of broken promises, enough of politicians using them as props. Dr. Thomas has given them a cause they can believe in. And when the people move, power moves with them."
