Vivitrol Treatment

The practice administers Vivitrol (naltrexone), a once-monthly, non-addictive injection that reduces cravings and blocks the euphoric effects of alcohol and opioids - an ideal solution for patients in recovery who prefer medication support without daily dosing requirements.

Crisis Stabilization & Rapid Access

Understanding that mental health challenges don't follow a schedule, Global Behavioral Health offers rapid appointments and short-term interventions for patients in crisis or returning to care after a treatment gap.
