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TOP 10 ITEMS TO PREPARE FOR YOUR L-1 VISA PETITION

1 CORPORATE RELATIONSHIP EVIDENCE

- Incorporation certificates for both U.S. and foreign entities.
- Shareholder structure documents.
- Organizational chart showing ownership
- Proof of financial control (e.g. share certificates, tax returns, or annual reports)

Goal: Show a qualifying relationship (parent, subsidiary, affiliate, or branch)

2 PROOF OF ONGOING BUSINESS ACTIVITIES

- Recent financial statements or bank records.
- Invoices, contracts or client correspondence
- Business licenses and leases for premises
- Payroll summaries or employee rosters

Goal: Demonstrate both entities are active and operational

3 DETAILED JOB DESCRIPTIONS

- Past role abroad (with specific duties, reporting lines, and authority)
- Future U.S. role (including managerial or executive functions)
- Explain how duties differ between countries

Goal: Clearly establish that the transferee qualifies as a manager/executive (L-1A) or specialized knowledge employee (L-1B).

4 U.S. BUSINESS SETUP (FOR "NEW OFFICE" CASES)

- Leave agreement or proof of office premises
- Business plan and financial projections (12 month forecast)
- U.S. business bank account statements.

4 PROOF OF EMPLOYMENT ABROAD

- Pay slips or payroll records
- Employment contracts
- Work visa or residency document/citation (if stationed outside native country)
- HR letters confirming position and period of service

Goal: Verify one full year of continuous employment within the last three years.

6 ORGANIZATIONAL CHARTS

- Visual charts for both the foreign and U.S. entities.
- Titles, reporting lines, and departments
- Highlight the transferor's role in context

Goal: Illustrate management hierarchy and decision-making authority.

9 PASSPORT AND IMMIGRATION RECORDS

- Valid passport for at least six months beyond intended stay
- Copies of previous U.S. visas or I-94 records.
- Dependent documents (if applicable)

Goal: Ensure personal documentation is accurate and up to date.

10 LEGAL REVIEW & PETITION DRAFTING

- Form I-129 (and L supplement) completed accurately
- Attorney's cover letter explaining the case strategy

Goal: Ensures consistency and compliance before submission.
