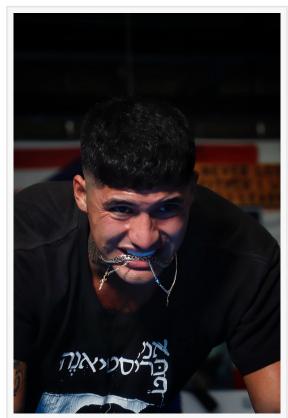


Chicago's Mario Herrera Unveils Focused Training Plan Ahead of 2026 Boxing Season
