

Addressing Adelaide's Growing Pigeon Population and Associated Risks

Tom's [Pest Control Adelaide](#) says uncontrolled pigeon populations are now causing health concerns, property damage, and high cleaning costs across the city.

A Growing Urban Issue

Adelaide's mild weather and abundance of food sources have made it ideal for pigeon breeding. The birds nest in roof cavities, signage, and air-conditioning units, leaving droppings that corrode surfaces and clog drains. In commercial areas, flocks have become large enough to disrupt foot traffic and dining spaces.

A spokesperson from Tom's said, “We're seeing a sharp rise in pigeon-related callouts, especially around shopping centres and heritage buildings. Droppings are not only unsightly but also carry bacteria and parasites. When left untreated, they create both health and maintenance issues.”

The Health Risks

Pigeon droppings can contain pathogens such as *Histoplasma capsulatum* and *Cryptococcus neoformans*, which can cause respiratory illnesses in humans. Dried droppings become airborne dust that spreads through ventilation systems.

“Many businesses don't realise the hidden risks,” the spokesperson explained. “Staff in warehouses or maintenance teams working near droppings are often exposed. Cleaning without



proper protection can lead to infection."

The problem extends to homes. Nesting pigeons attract mites and other parasites that spread to ceilings and furniture. Their constant presence also creates noise and odour issues, especially in apartment complexes.

Property Damage and Financial Loss

Pigeon droppings are acidic and eat through paint, metal, and concrete.

Over time, this corrosion leads to expensive repairs. Blocked drains and gutters can cause roof leaks, while nesting materials increase fire hazards in air-conditioning systems.

For businesses, the damage is often visible. Outdoor dining areas, balconies, and entryways stained by droppings deter customers and violate health regulations.

"We've helped restaurants that were losing business because pigeons roosted above their signs," the spokesperson said. "After installing deterrents, their outdoor seating became usable again."

"Sanitation is the first step," the spokesperson said. "If you install deterrents on dirty surfaces, pigeons come back. A clean site tells them the area is no longer suitable for nesting."

Broader City Impact

The growing pigeon population affects more than private properties. Council buildings, transport hubs, and historic landmarks face the same problem. Bird droppings accelerate the deterioration of stone and metal, threatening Adelaide's architectural heritage.

Tom's works with local councils to provide long-term control strategies for public infrastructure. "Prevention protects the city's image and reduces maintenance costs," the spokesperson said. "Pigeon management should be treated like any other essential service."

Preventive Steps for Residents

The company recommends simple actions to discourage pigeons around homes and businesses:

- Keep outdoor eating areas clean and free of food waste.
- Seal gaps or openings under roofs where birds can nest.
- Remove standing water and fix leaks that attract pigeons.
- Avoid feeding wild birds in public spaces.
