

Ti Global Group Reports Continued Multi Sector Expansion

The organisation, operating between Australia and Bangladesh, continues to adopt a structured approach to growth supported by consistent internal systems and long term planning.

The group's first division, Optek International, was established after founder Tahamidul Islam observed challenges faced by international students upon his arrival in Australia. Many students found it difficult to navigate the education system due to inconsistent information and reliance on informal advice. In response, he began offering clear and structured guidance, which later developed into a formal service. Over time, Optek International expanded into a full education and migration support division with defined processes and documented procedures.

A key development in the organisation's forward movement was the opening of Optek International's Dhaka branch. The branch was designed with trained counsellors, standardised workflows, and structured documentation systems to support student applications originating from Bangladesh. According to the organisation, this expansion aligns with its cross border model and allows it to manage higher volumes of student cases while maintaining consistent processes across both countries.

As the group grew, it identified increasing demand for digital support among businesses in Australia and Bangladesh. To address this, Ti Global Group launched Delco IT, its digital and creative services division. Delco IT offers branding, content development, UI and UX design, social media management, and corporate communication support. The division operates through scheduled projects and coordinated workflows managed across teams in Sydney and Dhaka. Its responsibilities include supporting external clients and managing Ti Global Group's

internal communication and design requirements.

Ti Global Group later expanded into the community care sector through Dimensions Support Australia. This division provides structured support services under Australian regulatory frameworks. Its operations involve documentation, compliance oversight, service coordination, and internal reporting. Dimensions Support Australia follows the same structured operational model as the group's other divisions, emphasising consistency and procedural clarity.

The group's entry into the technology sector came with the development of Apply Anywhere, a recruitment and applicant management platform. The platform integrates automation to help employers manage communication, application tracking, and workflow organisation. Apply Anywhere is designed to support both domestic and cross border recruitment and represents Ti Global Group's strategic move into digital infrastructure and technological solutions.

Across all divisions, the group maintains a consistent internal structure. Teams in Sydney and Dhaka work through shared digital systems, standardised processes, and clearly defined roles. The organisation avoids informal or ad hoc decision making, instead relying on documented procedures to maintain alignment across departments and locations. This structure forms the basis for the organisation's ability to expand while maintaining operational stability.

Bangladesh remains an important part of the organisation's growth strategy. The Dhaka operations support student services, digital production, and future expansion plans across multiple sectors. Staff in Bangladesh follow workflow systems modelled on those used in Australia, including communication guidelines, documentation templates, and process management tools. This alignment enables the organisation to maintain uniform output across both locations.

Ti Global Group reports ongoing development activities within each division.

Optek International is strengthening institutional partnerships and expanding its capacity for managing visa applications.

Delco IT is refining its digital service offerings and exploring opportunities to work with a broader client base.

Dimensions Support Australia is reviewing its compliance structure and documenting operational processes for future community service programs.

Apply Anywhere is building additional features to support larger organisations and more complex hiring networks.

The organisation's growth strategy continues to prioritise structured expansion over rapid or promotional growth. Its internal approach focuses on system development, steady progress, and maintaining operational clarity across sectors. According to internal sources, this model allows the organisation to manage cross border activities without compromising on consistency or regulatory alignment.

Ti Global Group states that it will continue investing in workflow systems, cross country coordination, and sector specific planning as part of its long term development roadmap. Further updates will be released as its divisions progress into their next phases of operational growth.
