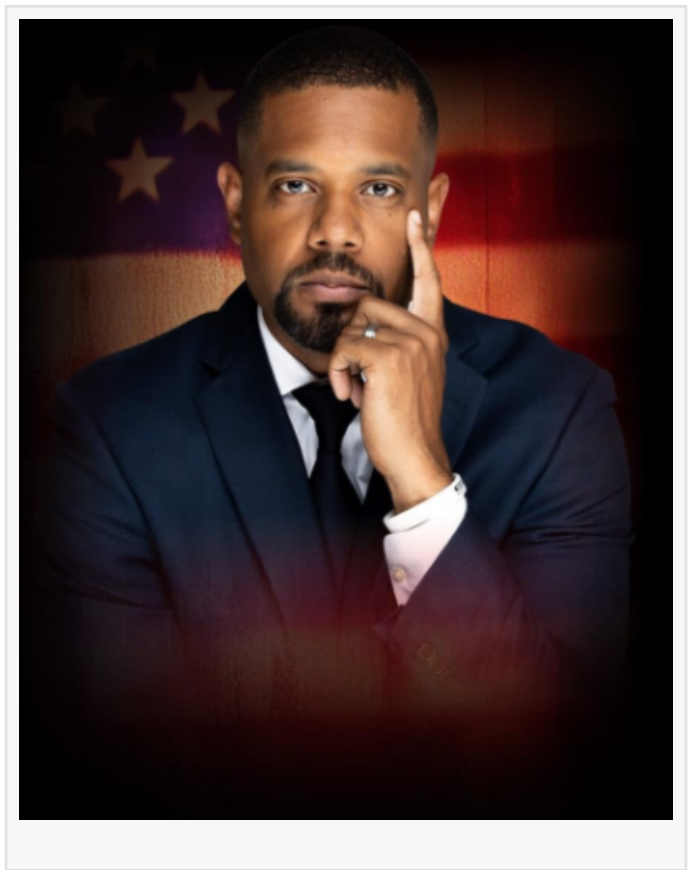


Andrew Shepherd Joins Operation CEO
