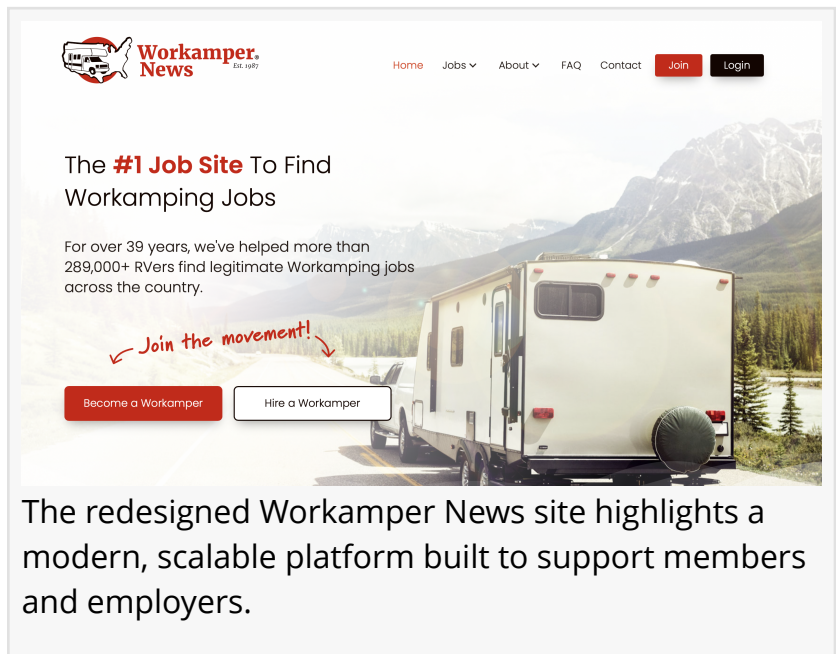


# Valyr Launches Workamping Job Platform for Workamper News
