Installing insulation, sealed environments, or dehumidifiers can help prevent these risks, even in residential garages.

Beyond equipment, Lockhart urges collectors to evaluate factors such as ceiling height, floor strength, and frequency of vehicle access before selecting a lift system. A rarely driven showpiece might remain elevated for months, while weekend drivers require lifts that offer easy and reliable operation. Professional lift installation for car collectors and regular inspections are essential to ensure long-term safety for both people and vehicles.
