OLN Great Debates in Solid Tumors is designed around discussion-driven debates that test evidence in real time.

Clinicians can move between concurrent debates spanning gastrointestinal, lung, breast, gynecologic, and genitourinary cancers based on what is most relevant to their practice.

The meeting is structured to help clinicians make better-informed treatment decisions when guidelines alone are not sufficient. Faculty experts challenge what the latest studies mean for patient care, clarify where evidence is strong, and highlight where uncertainty continues to shape treatment sequencing challenges.
