

two19 Launches Global Platform Redefining How Independent Builders Access Support, Funding, and Community

Serving founders and creators across tech, nonprofits, art, and impact, two19 delivers fellowship, direct services, and funding outside traditional pipelines.

Headquartered in Sheridan, Wyoming and operating fully remotely, two19 connects independent builders, thinkers, organizers, and creators — and makes space for their work to keep going. That support takes different forms depending on what a project actually needs: sometimes funding, sometimes collaborators, sometimes visibility or tools. Sometimes, as the platform puts it, just time to think.

Two19 is not a venture capital firm. It is not a grant competition. It is not a professional networking club. It is a platform for real work — spanning tech, nonprofits, research, art, education, and everything in between — built on the conviction that good projects deserve support that does not come at the cost of their integrity.

What two19 Offers

Two19 organizes its support around three core areas, each designed to meet people where they are rather than require them to conform to a fixed program or application process.

Fellowship

Participants can join or host circles where ideas and people take root. The fellowship model is built around ongoing relationship rather than cohort completion — a structure designed for the kind of slow, iterative work that does not fit neatly into a twelve-week program.

Services

Founders and project leads receive hands-on support across the full company cycle — strategy, design, development, community building, storytelling, and funding models. two19 works directly with each team, with no templates and no outsourcing, in working sessions shaped by what a project actually needs at the stage it's in.

Funding

Two19 helps projects explore non-extractive funding models — including mutual aid structures, DAO-based community funds, and other alternatives to traditional equity investment or competitive grant cycles. The goal is to find funding arrangements that support the work without distorting it.

Who two19 Is For

Two19 works with independent builders, early-stage founders, researchers, artists, organizers, educators, and anyone else engaged in substantive work that does not fit neatly into conventional funding or professional development pipelines. The platform spans tech, creative and media, fintech, web4, impact, nonprofit, and AI — with no single sector dominant and no minimum stage of development required.

What members share is not an industry or a business model. It is an orientation toward doing meaningful work seriously — and a recognition that the infrastructure most platforms offer was not built with them in mind.

A Different Model of Support

The platforms that dominate professional networking, startup funding, and talent development were largely built for a specific kind of project: venture-backable, scalable, and legible to institutional gatekeepers. That leaves a significant portion of meaningful work — research that does not commercialize cleanly, creative projects that do not pitch well, community organizations that do not optimize for growth — without adequate infrastructure.

Two19 is an attempt to build something different: a platform where the work itself is the criterion, and where support is offered without the expectation of extraction — no equity stake, no performance metrics, no requirement to become something other than what the project already is.

Redefining the HR and Talent Support Space

Two19 positions itself within the broader HR and talent ecosystem as an alternative — not a replacement — to existing models. Where traditional recruiting operates on volume and placement fees, two19 facilitates introductions based on alignment and shared purpose. Where executive advisory relies on retainer structures, two19 offers focused working sessions with direct access to its founding team. Where venture sourcing filters by return potential, two19 helps founders explore funding models that do not require them to optimize for an investor's timeline.

AI is used internally to support matchmaking and alignment processes — helping the team identify where genuine fit exists across a large and diverse network. It is one tool among several, not a defining feature of who the platform serves.

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
