Ken Goodwin of Goodwin Made announces the release of his deeply personal song "[Missing My Baby](#)," shared in honor of an employee whose son tragically died by suicide at the age of 12. The song is being respectfully released on the anniversary of his passing as a gesture of remembrance and compassion.

The decision to release the song on this date reflects a commitment to acknowledge the profound pain families experience after the loss of a child and to honor a young life who continues to be deeply loved and remembered.

Suicide remains a significant public health concern. According to the [World Health Organization](#), more than 720,000 people die by suicide worldwide each year — approximately one life every 40 seconds. In the United States, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that suicide is one of the leading causes of death among youth and young adults ages 10–24, underscoring the urgent need for greater awareness and compassionate support for families affected by suicide.

"Missing My Baby" explores the complex emotional journey many parents face after such loss — including overwhelming grief, anger, confusion, and the difficult process of learning to live with absence. The song was written to give voice to emotions that are often carried quietly and to create space for understanding.

The emotional center of the song comes in the bridge:

"He whispers, 'Your baby's with Me..."

And this wasn't yours to outrun."

Goodwin shared the inspiration behind the song:

"There are no words that can fully describe the pain of losing a child, especially at such a young age. This song was written with deep care and empathy to honor a mother's love, remember her son's life, and acknowledge the reality of grief that so many families endure. The hope is simply to let those who are hurting know they are not alone."

Vocalist Jaime Arin, whose emotional performance anchors the song, also reflected on the meaning behind the project:

"Being a part of 'Missing My Baby' was deeply important to me. Ken's thoughtful and powerful lyrics allowed me to serve as a vessel for a story that carries so much weight and emotion. Together, we share a message of grief, love, and loss — and the strength it takes to keep going in the face of it all."

The release is intended as a quiet tribute recognizing the strength of parents who carry both love and loss each day. It also encourages thoughtful conversations surrounding mental health, bullying, and the lasting impact suicide has on families and communities.
