

# Corona Foot and Ankle Group Introduces Advanced Diagnostic Technology to Detect Circulation Issues, Neuropathy Earlier

*New in-office testing supports prevention-focused care for seniors, patients with diabetes, and those at risk of foot complications*

The technology, known as SMART-ABI (ankle-brachial index), measures circulation in the lower extremities and can also support the assessment of small-fiber neuropathy. The addition reinforces Dr. Amin's prevention-focused approach to care, particularly for seniors, patients with diabetes, and others at higher risk for wounds and limb-threatening conditions.

"Too often, patients don't realize there's an issue with circulation or nerve function until a small problem becomes something much more serious," said Dr. Amin.

"When we can measure and explain what's happening earlier, we have a much better opportunity to educate patients, monitor them appropriately, and intervene before complications develop."

Dr. Amin said the diagnostic tool allows patients to better understand their individual risk factors, especially why even minor cuts, scrapes, or pressure points on the foot should be taken seriously when blood flow is compromised or neuropathy is present.

The technology also helps differentiate between types of neuropathy, which can influence treatment decisions and referrals. In some cases, symptoms that appear to be typical neuropathy may instead be linked to underlying conditions such as nerve compression or other systemic factors.

“This is about giving patients clarity,” Dr. Amin said. “When patients understand their numbers and what they mean, they are more engaged in their care and more likely to take action when something changes.”

Known for combining advanced diagnostics with a highly personalized approach, Dr. Amin’s practice emphasizes identifying root causes, educating patients, and preventing recurrence, not just treating symptoms as they arise. The office is equipped with in-house digital systems, including imaging and X-ray capabilities, allowing for a more streamlined and responsive patient experience.
