Carrollton training facility offers structured puppy training ahead of National Puppy Day as DFW dog ownership continues to grow

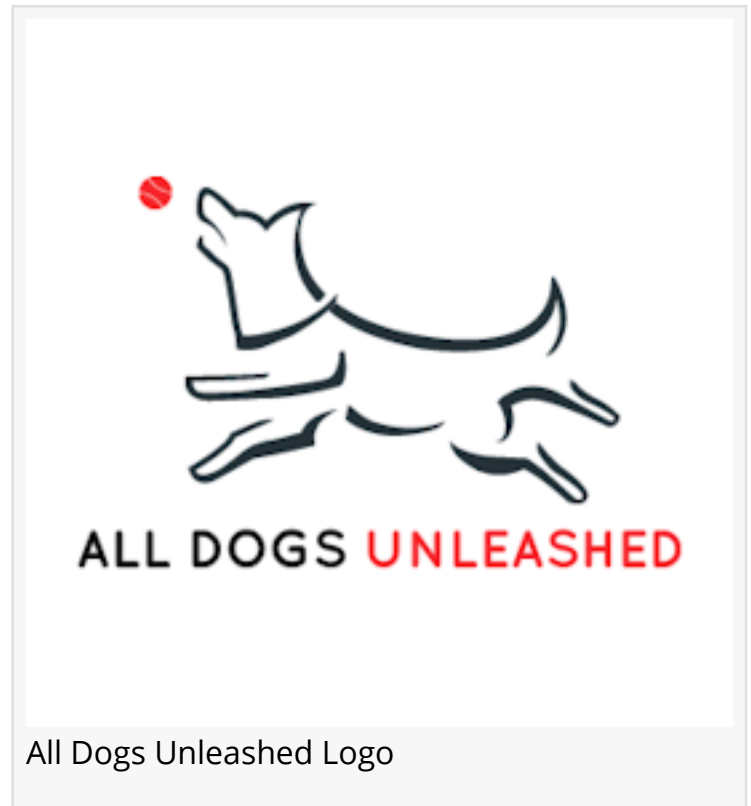

The Carrollton facility at 2401 Luna Road offers puppy training that focuses on crate success, leash manners, potty timing, and impulse control. The program teaches puppies to sit, stay, heel, and come when called while addressing early behavioral tendencies such as nipping, jumping, and nuisance barking before they become long-term habits.

"The window for effective puppy training is short, and the habits formed early set the tone for the dog's entire life," said Brian Claeys, Co-Founder and Managing Partner of All Dogs Unleashed. "We see owners come in frustrated after waiting too long, and the work is harder. Starting right is easier for the dog and the owner."

[All Dogs Unleashed in Carrollton, TX](#) provides two training paths for puppy owners. The Board and Train program brings puppies in for a two-week stay at the Carrollton facility, where certified trainers work with them daily in a structured environment with overnight staff on-site seven days a week. The In-Home Training option allows owners to participate directly in training sessions held at the owner's residence, addressing behaviors specific to the home environment.

The facility at 2401 Luna Road features outdoor turf play areas, climate-controlled kennels, and



indoor and outdoor socialization spaces. Staff administer medications when needed and maintain vaccinations compliance. Dogs are kept in a non-crowded environment to reduce stress and allow focused training attention.

The Dallas-Fort Worth metro area ranks among the top markets nationally for pet ownership, and dog ownership has grown steadily in recent years. The Carrollton facility serves the broader DFW region, and a second All Dogs Unleashed location at 211 N. Ervay Street in downtown Dallas provides additional access for urban dog owners.

All Dogs Unleashed has earned a 4.9-star rating across 1,352 Google reviews, and the Carrollton facility has been recognized among the top dog training providers in Dallas for 2025. The company has trained more than 12,000 dogs since opening in 2007.
