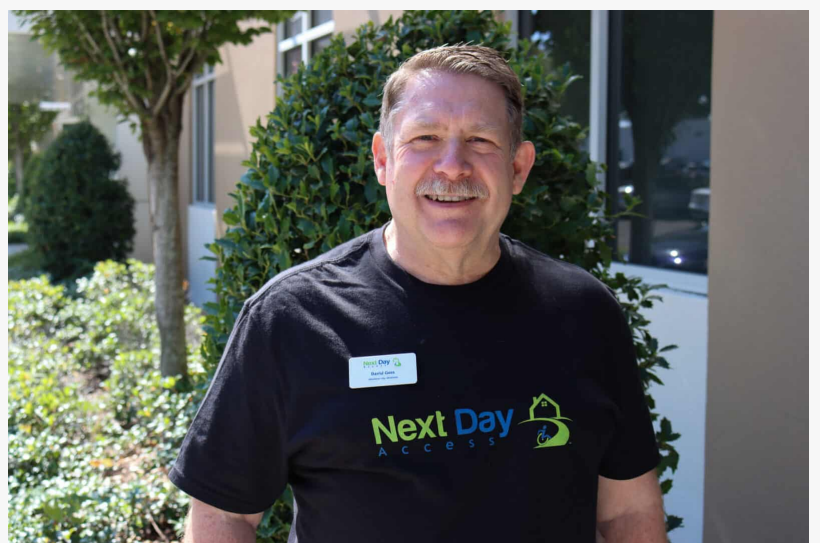
David and Angelia Goss bring a unique combination of operational expertise and healthcare experience to their growing business. Prior to becoming
