TEAs are typically rural areas or regions experiencing high unemployment, where investment is encouraged to stimulate economic growth.

In addition to meeting the financial threshold, EB-5 applicants must demonstrate that their investment will create at least 10 full-time jobs for U.S. workers. This requirement is central to the programme’s objective of supporting the U.S. economy through foreign investment.

Many investors choose to participate through regional centre projects, which allow for indirect job creation to be counted. This approach offers greater flexibility and has become a popular pathway within the
