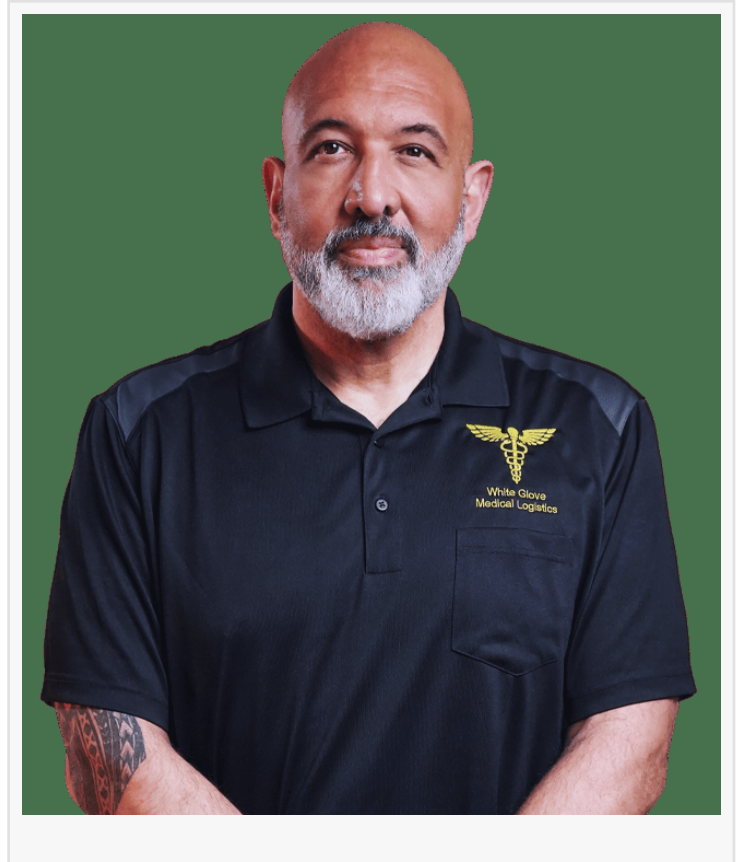


# Terrance Lackey Joins Operation CEO
