The project began when a Littlefield family contacted Master Air Duct LLC to request air duct cleaning. The family reported concerns about indoor comfort during visits from their grandson and wanted the duct system inspected and cleaned.

During the service visit, Master Air Duct LLC inspected the ductwork and observed visible microbial growth inside portions of the duct system. Based on the condition of the ductwork, the company advised the homeowners that routine cleaning may not provide the result they were seeking.

According to Master Air Duct LLC, duct cleaning can be appropriate when ductwork is in cleanable condition. However, when growth is heavy, widespread, or located within contaminated duct material, cleaning may not guarantee complete removal of all spores, particles, or microbial residue. In those situations, replacement may be recommended after inspection.

“Air duct cleaning is not a one-size-fits-all solution,” said a representative of Master Air Duct LLC. “When ductwork shows visible microbial growth or deterioration, the system should be evaluated before deciding whether cleaning, repair, or replacement is the appropriate option.”

After reviewing the findings, the homeowners approved duct replacement. The affected ductwork was removed and replaced with new ductwork. Approximately two weeks after the project, the family contacted Master Air Duct LLC and reported improved comfort during their grandson's visits. The customer later shared a 5-star Google review describing the experience.

Master Air Duct LLC says the project is being shared to raise awareness about the importance of duct inspections before homeowners choose a service. The company notes that duct systems may be affected by moisture, age, disconnected sections, damaged insulation, restricted airflow, or visible contamination.

The company encourages homeowners to schedule an inspection if they notice musty odors, visible growth near vents, excessive dust, weak airflow, uneven room temperatures, or ductwork that appears torn, crushed, disconnected, or deteriorated.

Master Air Duct LLC does not claim that duct cleaning or duct replacement cures allergies or medical conditions. The company says the Littlefield project is an example of why inspection-based recommendations are important when evaluating indoor air quality concerns and duct system conditions.
