The judging panel stated that D.AMO was selected as a winner in both Data Protection and Quantum Security for its innovative integration and implementation of Hybrid PQC (Post-Quantum Cryptography) algorithms and key management systems, built upon 20 years of proven reliability. WAPPLES was recognized for its precise logical detection capabilities and low false-positive rates driven by its proprietary COCEP engine. Cloudbric was honored for its exceptional accessibility combined with robust security performance. Meanwhile, iSIGN Password-less secured its finalist spot thanks to its OS-level unified authentication technology and a phased implementation model that resolves compatibility issues with existing infrastructure.

"Winning the most categories on the same stage as global security leaders reaffirms that Penta Security's technology is highly competitive on a global scale," said Jihae Lee, CCO (Chief Compliance Officer) of Penta Security.
