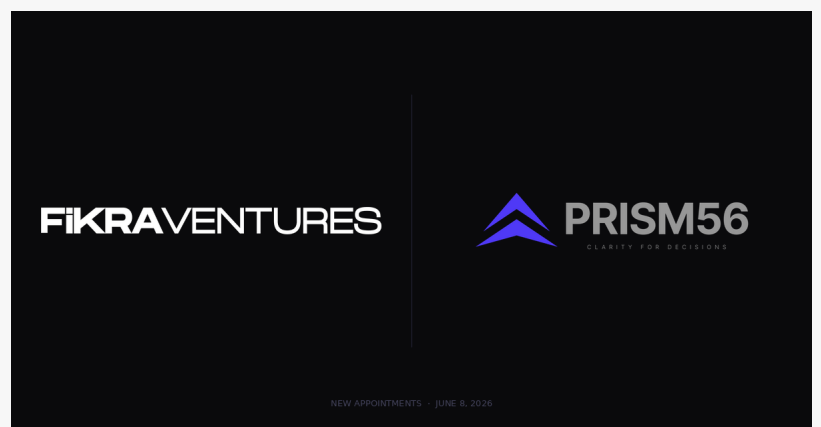


# Fikra Ventures Appoints Mohamed Nabil as Prism56 Co-Founder & CTO and Moatassem Abdelhaleem as EIR

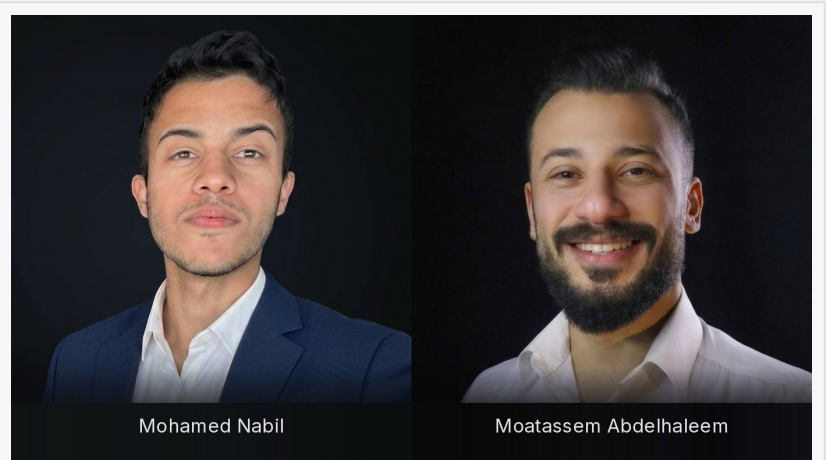
