

Red Sift featured in History of Parliament centenary book launch at Westminster Abbey

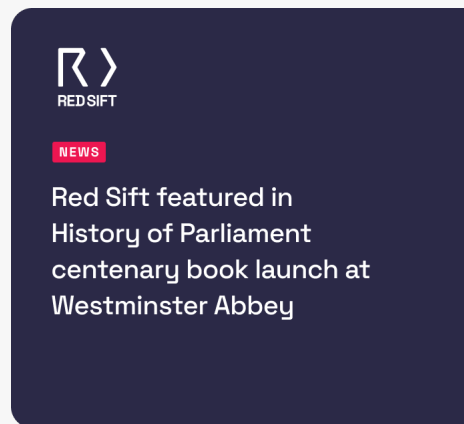
Monarchy and Democracy: A History of Leadership launches at Westminster Abbey, profiling Red Sift alongside organisations shaping innovation and industry.
