

Jalubro Launches J-10, an Enforcement Layer for Enterprise Governance

New platform turns governance policy into live, enforced controls across the systems, workflows and automated processes running inside regulated organisations.

LONDON, UNITED KINGDOM, June 8, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Jalubro, the enterprise transformation and technology consultancy, today launched J-10, a governance enforcement platform that ensures only approved actions execute across an organisation's operational systems, workflows and business processes.

Regulated enterprises run on policies, controls and approval structures, but those still live largely in documents, matrices and after-the-fact audits. They describe what should happen. Across a modern stack of connected systems, automation and AI, there has been no reliable way to enforce them at the moment work actually executes. Enforcement stays fragmented across departments, tools and workflows, and the gap between policy and execution is where operational and regulatory risk accumulates.

J-10 closes that gap. It sits as an enforcement layer across an organisation's existing stack, translating governance policies into executable controls that validate decisions before they execute, hold or escalate exceptions, and capture continuous, audit-grade evidence of what was allowed, what ran and why.

That enforcement applies uniformly to every action, however it originates. Whether a contract clause is approved, a purchase order is raised, a regulated filing is submitted, or an automated or AI-driven process touches sensitive data, J-10 checks the action against the organisation's own policies before it completes, and records the decision either way. As more work shifts to automation and AI, that consistency becomes the difference between governance that is documented and governance that is actually enforced.

The platform ships with sector packs that encode the governance requirements of specific industries out of the box. The legal pack governs how legal teams handle matters, contracts and privileged information; the healthcare pack enforces controls around regulated data and clinical workflows, with on-premise deployment for organisations that cannot send data off-site. Further packs extend J-10 across procurement, finance and compliance. No replacement of existing systems is required.

"Over the last decade we've worked alongside organisations as their operational environments became far more complex," said Arran Braganza, Founder and CEO of Jalubro. "They've invested heavily in systems, controls and, more recently, automation and AI. What stayed missing was any practical way to enforce governance consistently across all of it. J-10 was built to close that gap. It gives organisations a clear view of what is allowed to execute, what actually executed, and the evidence behind it."

"Governance can no longer rely on documentation alone," Braganza added. "As enterprise operations become more connected and more automated, organisations need governance that operates where work actually happens, in real time, on every action. That is what J-10 enforces."
