This geographic preference reflects a broader macro-trend where exclusivity is defined by verticality

and the absence of crowds rather than traditional luxury markers. As travelers seek to de-stress and reconnect, the architectural and geographical orientation of a destination becomes a primary factor in the decision-making process for significant life events.
