Colored gemstones also benefit from periodic cleaning. Sapphires, rubies, emeralds, garnets, topaz, amethyst, aquamarine, and other stones may gradually lose their visual vibrancy as dirt

and oils collect around settings and beneath gemstone surfaces. Proper cleaning techniques help restore clarity while respecting the unique properties of each gemstone.

Precious metals experience similar changes over time. Gold, platinum, silver, and other jewelry metals may lose their original luster through normal wear.
