From Guanacaste's Pacific beaches to cloud forests, volcanoes and remote villages, Costa Rica rewards travelers who explore by road. But road conditions vary widely: paved highways may give way to gravel public roads, potholes and steep mountain access, and the right vehicle makes the difference between a smooth trip and a stressful one. River crossings and off-road driving are not permitted, so travelers should avoid them.

Adobe's SUVs and 4x4s are on average around two years old, backed by 24/7 roadside assistance so visitors can drive with confidence on the country's diverse routes. The fleet ranges from compact cars for city driving to higher-clearance 4x4s suited to the more demanding roads that lead to many of Costa Rica's most memorable destinations.

Airport-area pickup and a nationwide network

Adobe operates 16 offices, including service in the area of Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO) near San José and in Guanacaste near Daniel Oduber Airport (LIR), the two main gateways for international visitors. Travelers can pick up their vehicle close to arrival and drop it off near the end of their itinerary, without unnecessary detours.

The wider network reaches San José, Alajuela, Heredia, Cartago, San Pedro, Grecia, Ciudad Quesada, Puntarenas, Quepos, Uvita, Puerto Viejo, Limón, Tamarindo/Flamingo, and Liberia. That footprint means support is available at multiple points along popular routes, which is particularly valuable on longer road trips.

A young fleet and local know-how

Because Adobe is 100% Costa Rican-operated, its team can recommend plans around the country's real conditions: rainy-season roads, popular touring loops and the practical needs of first-time visitors. The constant fleet renewal, keeping vehicles young, supports reliability and up-to-date safety features.

The company also holds current sustainable-tourism certifications, the CST from the ICT and the SICCS, Bandera Azul Ecológica and Carbon Neutral, and applies an all-inclusive, no-hidden-fees pricing policy, so the value proposition for a road trip is both practical and transparent.

Choosing the right vehicle is one of the most important decisions when planning a Costa Rica road trip. Popular routes combine paved highways with gravel access roads, and some destinations, particularly in the mountains and along the coast, are more comfortably reached in a higher-clearance SUV or 4x4.

Adobe's average-two-years fleet is designed to cover this range, from efficient compacts for shorter city-based trips to 4x4s for multi-region itineraries. Because the vehicles are recent models, travelers benefit from up-to-date safety and comfort features on long driving days.
