Throughout her years in practice, Kimura-Galzina has pursued continuing education in both traditional and modern acupuncture methods. More recently, the clinic introduced [AcuNova Acupuncture](#), a specialized acupuncture approach intended to support eye health and visual function. AcuNova is offered as a complementary service for patients who are continuing to receive appropriate care from their ophthalmologists and other eye-care professionals.

The addition of specialized services reflects the clinic's broader commitment to continued learning and to thoughtfully incorporating new approaches when they may benefit patients.

"Acupuncture has changed significantly during the past 18 years, and patients have also become more informed about their health and the options available to them," Kimura-Galzina said.
