

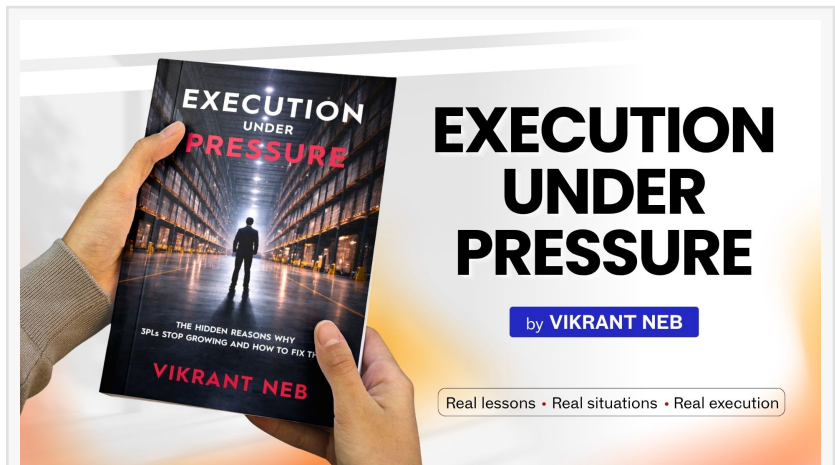
New Book 'Execution Under Pressure' by Vikrant Neb Helps Warehouse and 3PL Leaders Master Operational Growth

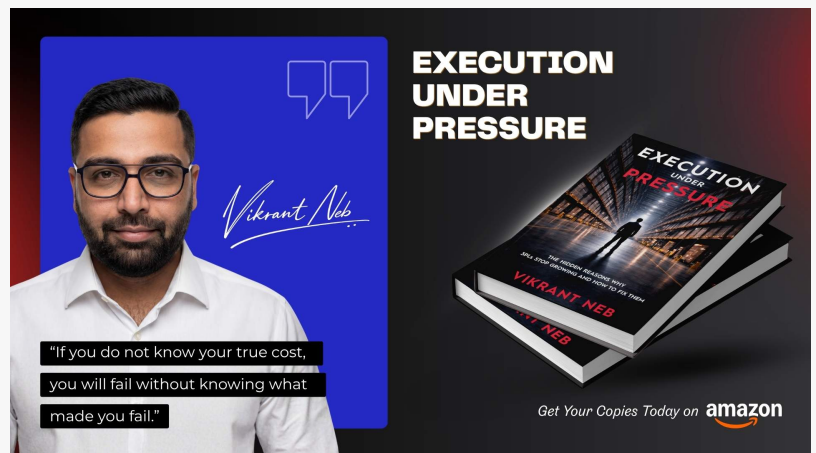

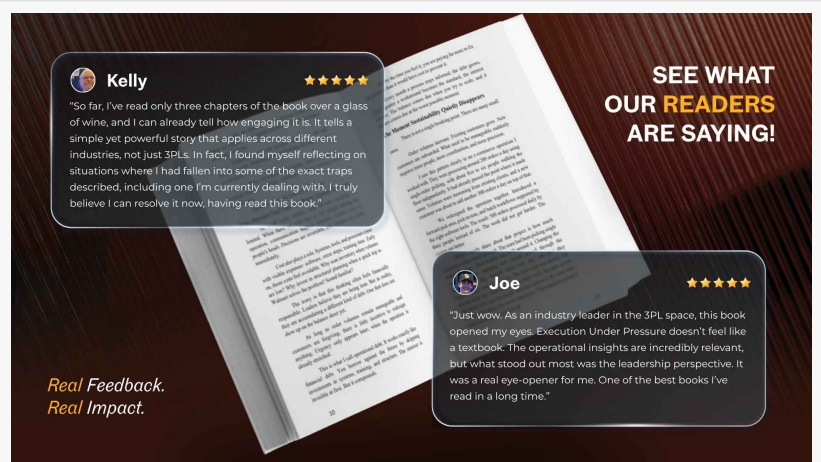
