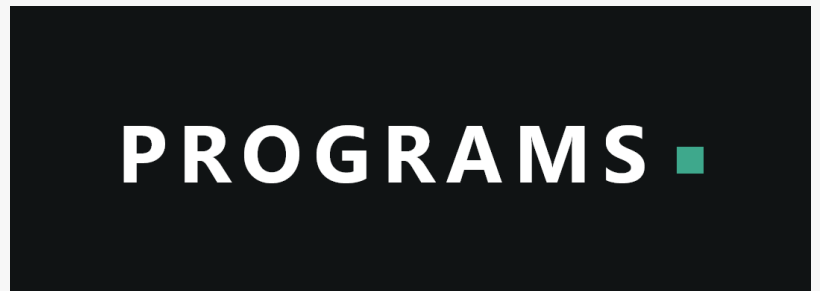


Programs.com Launches Expanded Site Focused on AI Degree Programs
