

Holland Injury Law, LLC Offers Driver Guidance for the Route 367 Corridor Improvement Project in North St. Louis County

CLAYTON, MO, UNITED STATES, August 6, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- The St. Louis firm has released a plain-language resource to help motorists understand the new medians, lane shifts, and traffic control changes taking shape between I-270 and Hall's Ferry Circle.

[Holland Injury Law, LLC](#), offering driver guidance for motorists using the Route 367 corridor in North St. Louis County, where the Missouri Department of Transportation is carrying out a significant safety improvement project.

The MoDOT project introduces new physical medians and speed deterrents along the corridor from I-270 down to Hall's Ferry Circle. While the completed work is intended to make the route safer over the long term, the construction phase itself changes how the corridor behaves day to day: lane configurations shift, heavy equipment enters and exits active traffic, temporary markings replace permanent ones, and familiar turning movements are closed off or relocated.

Holland Injury Law's new drive explains those changes in plain language. The firm is assisting drivers in how temporary traffic control plans work, what the different work zone signs and markings mean, why lane positions on the corridor may not match a driver's memory of the route or their navigation app, and what documentation drivers should keep if they are involved in an incident anywhere within an active work zone.

Company founder William K. Holland stated:



"A construction corridor is one of the most complicated driving environments there is, and most people are never taught how to read one. Drivers are asked to interpret temporary markings, adjust to lane shifts that changed since last week, and share the road with heavy equipment, all at highway speed. We work with people who have been through incidents in these environments, and the same theme comes up again and again: nobody explained what was actually changing. Offering this guidance is the most useful thing we can do with what we've learned."

The firm also encourages drivers traveling the Route 367 corridor to take three basic precautions:

- Reduce speed on approach to and throughout the work zone
- Signal early and clearly before any lane change
- Watch for shifting lane markers rather than relying on memory or navigation prompts
