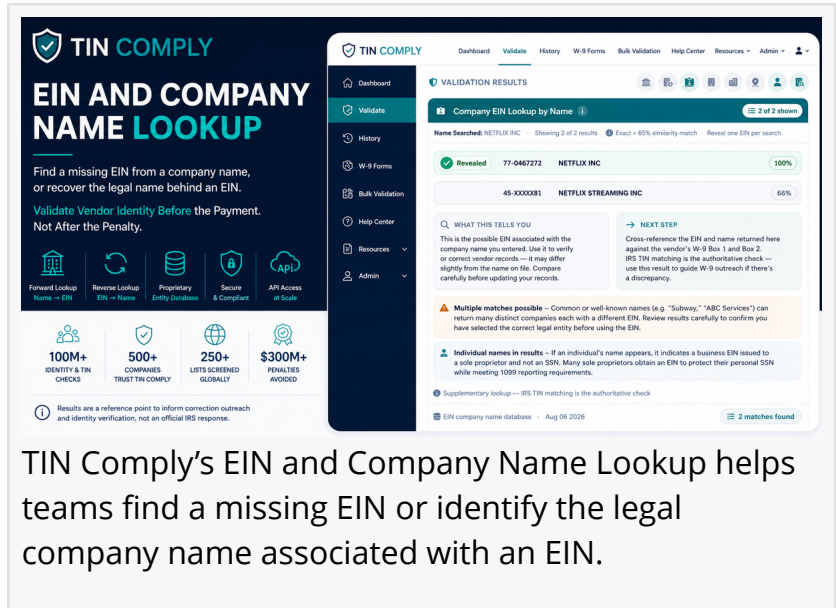


TIN Comply Launches EIN and Company Name Lookup for Vendor Identity Checks

The feature works two ways. A forward lookup takes a legal company name and returns the associated EIN — useful when a vendor is onboarded with a missing or unconfirmed identifier. A reverse lookup takes an EIN and returns the corresponding legal entity name, which TIN Comply describes as "a fast independent reference point before a contract is signed."

Results draw on TIN Comply's proprietary entity database and are meant as "a reference point to inform correction

outreach and identity verification, not an official IRS response." The company recommends using the lookup alongside its [IRS TIN Matching](#) for final confirmation. Teams can run single lookups through the web portal or process them "at scale via API."

TIN Comply highlights several workflows the feature is built for: correcting name mismatches after a failed TIN validation, verifying an entity before contract execution, cross-checking identity before a payment in treasury operations, cleaning up vendor master data during procurement onboarding, and supporting M&A due diligence and fraud screening.

The feature is relevant across the many industries TIN Comply serves — including accounts payable, procurement, banking and financial services, legal, healthcare, and government — where a missing or mismatched EIN is a common root cause of 1099 filing errors, IRS B-Notices, and penalties.

EIN and Company Name Lookup is part of the broader TIN Comply platform, which also provides IRS TIN matching, W-9 collection, OFAC and global sanctions screening, bulk file processing, audit-ready reporting, an API, and AI Connections for running checks directly inside AI assistants.
